I am an Assistant Professor at Arizona State University in the Counseling & Counseling Psychology program. I serve as Associate Editor of the Journal of Adolescent Research. I completed my undergraduate and doctoral degrees at New York University, and a master's degree at Harvard University.

I received the Emerging Professional Contributions to Research Award, an early career award given Division 45 of APA. I was selected as a Faculty Fellow by the Ford Foundation and the American Association of Hispanics in Higher Education. My research has been funded by the National Science Foundation/National Institute of Health.

I am the author or co-author of 24+ articles published in peer reviewed journals and several book chapters. I co-edited a book published by APA Press on ethnic-racial identity. I co-edited a special section of the Journal of Counseling Psychology and New Directions for Child and Adolescent Development, both on intersectionality-inspired research in psychology.
