



We're already receiving outpatient care with a therapist, psychiatrist, and dietitian. How is Equip's treatment different?

Equip's team actively works together to provide comprehensive care that's enhanced by peer and family support. Equip also tailors treatment plans to your family's needs.

How does your virtual treatment work?

All treatment sessions occur via secure video calls. Patients and families can schedule appointments with providers and send messages to their providers between sessions using the Equip platform.

How do we monitor care in a virtual environment?

Families do weight and orthostatic vitals at home every week to start. We will walk you through the steps and our medical doctors review the data to monitor medical stability.

What happens if my child refuses to follow treatment at home?

This concern is so common and we know how difficult it can be to manage everything at home. Equip's team of experts develop treatment plans and safety plans, and our mentors are an excellent resource to relate and help strengthen the part of your child that wants to be free from this eating disorder.
